MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION (COMPANY LIMITED BY GUARANTEE) UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013

[Pursuant to rule 19(2) the Companies (Incorporation and Incidental) Rules, 2014].

- 1. The name of the company is: "ATMAJYOTI SANATAN DHARM SEVA FOUNDATION"
- 2. The registered office of the Company shall be situated in the State of "MAHARASHTRA".
- 3. The objects for which the company is established are:
- A. The main objects of the company to be pursued by the company on its incorporation
- 1. To be and act and serve as non-profit organization of Kutch Kadva Patidar Sanatan community, ("the Community") residing all over the world for and development and promotion of industries, trade and professions, commerce, art, science, sports, education, research, medical, health, community welfare, social welfare, Sanatan Hindu religion and spirituality, protection of environment, strengthening national integrity including carrying out of charitable activities for the society as a whole by the Community and to promote, manage, establish, maintain, encourage, organize and assist in the said development and promotional activities for the Community which will empower them to lead the life in accordance with Truth and high Morality at all levels and will help in their economic, social, spiritual and overall empowerment.
- B. Matters that are necessary for the furtherance of the objects specified in clause 3(A) are:
 - 1. To promote Hindu religion by organizing religious programs with the help of Religious Priests & Saints and to spread the teachings & thoughts of great philosophers, thinkers, reformers and saints of Hindu Religion.
 - 2. To inculcate the Sanatana Dharma and to help the poor and needy of the society, as service to human beings is service to God.
 - 3. To undertake and organize religious events, activities aimed at strengthening the moral fibre of the society and improve the standard of living.
 - 4. To launch programs aimed at spreading the spirit of universal brotherhood, amity and peace. To strive to remove discord and prejudices because heaven is harmony.
 - 5. To organize conferences to bring all religious and warring groups on a common platform and help them establish a true religion of man aimed at spiritual and social welfare of mankind through the language of love and noble deeds.
 - 6. To organise spiritual, philosophical, recreational and cultural activities for the younger members of the society to develop their self-esteem, self-respect and self-confidence and to mould them into caring, compassionate, disciplined, law-abiding and responsible members of the community;

- 7. To recognise and honour the contributions and sacrifices of the elderly in the society by facilitating and encouraging their participation in religious, cultural, recreational and social activities.
- 8. To organise, facilitate, hold, functions and events to mark, publicise and celebrate religious and cultural festivals and to demonstrate their significance in a multi-cultural and multi-religious society;
- 9. To print, publish, sell, distribute, scriptures, booklets, publications, newspapers, materials which promote, foster, advance and enhance the knowledge, understanding of the principles, philosophy, practices and teaching of the Hindu faith, spiritual and religious beliefs and Hinduism in general and other periodical illustration for generating income for the trust for the benefit of its aims.
- 10. To construct, maintain and manage temple, monuments, ashrams, convention centres, Audotoriums, function halls, meditation, yoga & kriya centers and spiritual centres for the benefit of trust members, their families and the general public of the area.
- 11. To construct, maintain, alter, improve or develop any building belonging to the trust or works necessary or convenient for purpose of the trust.
- 12. To look after the general administration of the all the activities of temple. To perform the daily pooja to the deities and to arrange special poojas on festival days.
- 13. Devotees perform outreach activities by meeting in different places and conducting Bhajans and religious discourses message to the public.
- 14. To establish and run libraries, research centers and museums and assist individuals and institutions involved in such spiritual cultural activities.
- 15. To establish contact, liaise, communicate, co-operate, collaborate, assist, join and maintain regular and on-going contacts with bodies, organizations and institutions which have similar aims and objectives as the Trust
- 16. To take over, absorb or amalgamate with any other trust or society or association or institution whose objects are similar to the objects of this trust.
- 17. To Spreading & creating awareness regarding Gau-Palan & Gau-Raksha & to built & maintain Gau-shala at various place all over india.

- 18. To promote & conduct classes for traditional therapies like Yoga, Naturopathy, Meditation, Acupressure, Acupuncture, Massage Therapy, Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Reiki, Music, Sanskrit, Drama and Vedas, etc., for the benefit of trust members, their families and the general public of the area.
- 19. To promote and protect natural herbs and plants by cultivation, preservation, storage, processing, demonstration, creating botanical garden and providing necessary training.
- 20. To promote and support voluntary donation of Blood, Eyes and other parts of human body for charitable purpose.
- 21. To provide Ambulance, blood bank & mother milk bank services to all irrespective all class & caste of people.
- 22. To encourage members of the community to participate in voluntary, philanthropic, humanitarian and charitable services to assist the disadvantaged, poor, elderly, needy and the underprivileged;
- 23. To provide medical, emotional, psychological, social and medical support to senior citizens of our trust by setting up various drop-in centers, senior citizen homes, old-age homes and other entertainment centers so that these highly honorable people should not be neglected.
- 24. To arrange and provide medical aid and other assistance necessary for living to the needy people who are incapable or handicapped or mentally/physically retarded and financially unfit.
- 25. To run the different types of health programmes to raise the health status of vulnerable groups, poor and needy.
- 26. To provide financial aid to institutions and organizations taking care of health and hygiene.
- 27. To start, manage and administer any Orphanage, Nursing home, Old age Homes, Hospitals, libraries, Diagnostic Centres, Reading rooms, Schools, colleges, ITI institutes, Research Institutions and other institution and extend its benefits to society at large irrespective of caste, creed or social status and to acquire land and building and other assets and properties for achieving the objects of the Trust.
- 28. To promote and establish, and administer educational and vocational school or institution or college or deemed university and to run the same for educational or vocational or skill development & training purposes, in various places throughout India as well as outside India, subject to various permissions as required, with a motive to render service to the public and especially to economically backward students.
- 29. Providing for grants, scholarships, fellowships and other forms of financial assistance to the needy and deserving students for pursuing education, vocational training, skill development etc.

- 30. To establish and maintain welfare hostels, ashrams, dharamshalas, skill training centers and as such to render assistance to the poor, marginalized, minority groups, handicapped, widows, orphans, street children, homeless, aged and victims of disaster and calamities.
- 31. To promote gender equality; empowering women; setting up homes and hostels for women and orphans; setting up old age homes; day care centres and such other facilities for senior citizens and economically backward groups.
- 32. To accept donations grants, presents and offerings, in cash or in kind from persons, association of persons, firms, companies, institutions, universities in India & abroad and to deal with the same for the purpose of achieving the objects of the trust mentioned above upon such terms and conditions as trustees may think fit and consistent with the objects of the trust.
- 33. To lift the public from the curses of poverty, hunger, illiteracy and diseases by starting and carrying out concentrated and intensive programs.
- 34. To promote cultural and artistic subjects / works like Drawings, paintings, music, shows dramatic performances and dances reflecting / exhibiting the preaching of all religions heads of India, and Indian cultures / traditions.
- 35. To support and promote the growing of trees and drilling of bore wells, restoration of water tanks, taking up drinking water projects, water development programs and providing of space and rooms for conducting religious functions or any other allied activities as the trustees deem fit from time to time.
- 36. To acquire, purchase or otherwise own or under take on loan or lease or hire temporality or permanently and movable or immovable property necessary or convenient for the furtherance of the objects of the trust
- 37.. To spread the messages of preserving and conserving the Indian culture and save the same from influence of the western cultures throughout India and in all foreign countries.
- 38. To help and to provide relief to the poor irrespective of caste, creed, race, religion or
- 39. To protest and fight against the injustice against people.
- 40. To aware people about various social issues to fight against evils.
- 41. To provide and facilitate legal assistance to underprivileged and poor section of trust to fight for their rights and justice.
- 42. Providing free meals and Bundara's in festivals and functions to all mass of society.

- 43. To provide all type of assistance, cloths, food, residence, meditation rooms & Medicine and help to Sadhu/Sant/Sadhvise and Bhamacharies.
- 44. To provide and arrange yatras for Sadhu/Sant/Sadhvise and Bhamacharies.
- 45. To facilitate the participation of younger members of the society in youth camps or similar undertakings or projects to enable them to recognise and develop their full potential, abilities and talents for their own individual wellbeing and that of the advancement of the larger community;
- 46. To spread the messages of preserving and conserving the Indian culture and save the same from influence of the western cultures throughout India and in all foreign countries.
- 47. To start and run rehabilitation centers for mentally retarded, physically handicapped persons and deaddiction centers.
- 48. To provide basic medical facility, sanitation, general health care and other needful support which can be helpful for public to overcome sufferings and agony of any natural and manmade disaster and to facilitate them to rehabilitate.
- 49. To communicate and coordinate with the Govt. Local and public authorities on various issues related to development welfare and public interest on different subjects.
- 50. To promote and protect Indian Traditional music, dance, handicraft, handlooms, Art, modern art & literature.
- 51. To support the families and relatives of artists for promoting the budding artists in the trust;
- 52. To establish an award for the deserving people in the field of Music, Art grass root level social service, communal harmony, brotherhood and peace.
- 53. To encourage the emerging artists and their talents so that they can get proper recognition within and beyond the country.
- 54. To establish centre(s) for the promotion of Music, Dance and other Arts.
- 55. To promote and arrange Samuha Lagnas & re-marriage for all segment of community.
- 56. To support the people at time of any epidemics by providing infrastructure, medical & financial help.
- 57. To provide assistance at the last stage of life member of community by arranging the stay at mokshdam & helping them to perform the hindu funeral customs & rituals at Kashi.

- 58. To engage as far as possible in emergency social activities such as famine and relief work, helping the victims of natural calamities and other activities which will help and uplift the needy and underprivileged in our community.
- 59. To offer cooperation and assistance to benevolent schemes which are in accordance with the objects of the Trust, whether such schemes are undertaken by the State or Central Government, by public or private agencies, by religious or philanthropic organizations/ bodies.
- 60. To raise funds through donations, by request, by public subscription, by issuing appeals and by accepting contributions from State or Central Government, individuals, philanthropic bodies, religious bodies, institutions, local bodies and industrial concerns, limited or private, wheresoever's situated in the Union of India or abroad to fulfill the objects of the Trust.
- 61. To subscribe or give donations and to financially or otherwise aid educational, benevolent, spiritual, charitable institutions, works and activities of other Trust or Society whose objects coincide or promote all or some of the said objects of the Trust.
- 62. To invest or deposit money of the Trust, not immediately required for the purpose of the Trust, in a manner specified by the relevant rules in force from time to time.
- 63. To open and maintain offices, banking, telephones and other services in any part of the Union of India for carrying out the objects of the Trust.
- 64. To start or use television, radio, literature, internet, correspondence courses, satellite dishes etc. with the purpose to educate society in understanding of welfare, community health, development, spiritual, family life, human rights and lifestyle that may help improve the society.
- 65. To establish and maintain contact and cooperate with other institutions, organizations in and outside India, having similar objects of this Trust and if the need arises then to take over such institutions, organizations and carry out affairs of such bodies under the banner of this trust.
- 66. To receive Indian or foreign volunteers with various skills to assist, help, aid and participate and help fulfill the objects of the Trust.
- 67. To take up any other activities which may be decided by the Board of Trustees from time to time, which are not against the objects and basic principles of this Trust as mentioned in this Trust deed.
- 68. To do all such other lawful acts as may be necessary, incidental to or conducive to the attainment of the above aims and objects.
- 69. To invest excess fund in start-ups and early stage companies & business to support them to grow and bring stability in their ventures and generate the income to fulfil the object of trust.
- 70. To collaborate with other institutions such as academic, research, government, non-governmental institutions (NGOs); community based organizations (CBOs), civil society organizations (CSOs) and consultancy agencies both national and international in implementation of projects & programmes, undertaking studies & action research, and sharing of information.

- 71. To engage/invite and assist the services of experts for the promotion of main objects of the companyon payment of fees or remuneration of honorarium or otherwise.
- 72. To collect, gather and distribute statistical and technical information relating to the issues highlighted in the main objects of the company and for that purpose to print, publish, issue and circulate papers, periodicals, books, circulars and other literature, and hold seminars, meetings, conferences, discussions and produce and distribute films, cassettes.
- 73. To encourage and conduct research pertaining to the issues highlighted in the main objects of the company; and for that purpose, to establish, construct, promote, form and maintain necessary institutions; and to provide therein all technical assistance and other necessary facilities therein. Make payment to any association, organisation or academic institution to be used for research in any field.
- 74. To serve as a Resource Centre for collecting, storing, collating and disseminating suitable communication materials and information from different sources to complement the main objectives of the Company.

- 75. To survey all the matters in any way effecting or touching the business activities and profession and of any other developments thereof; and to decide upon intimating and supporting proper methods and /or channels to deal with and dispose of any contingency affecting or touching the said business, activity or profession that may arise and for that matter to co- operate and / or associate with other organizations with similar objects as the company
- 76. To acquire land with or without buildings and to construct thereon the building or buildings to achieve the objects and purpose of the company and / or to acquire suitable premises on ownership basis or onsuch other terms and conditions may be decided by the management
- 77. To purchase, rent, take on lease or in exchange or on leave and license, or otherwise acquire or obtainpossession of any moveable or immoveable property, rights or privileges which may be deemed necessary or convenient for any of the objects of the company from any person, Company, Society, Foundation, Trust, Organization and/or Institution
- 78. To raise necessary funds and accept donations, contributions (in cash or kind) subscriptions, grants of money, securities, and property of any kind and/or to undertake and accept the management of transfer ship of any endowment, trust fund or donation not inconsistent with the objects of the Company
- 79. To establish, operate, and engage in business activities for the purpose of revenue earning in order tomeet the main objects of the company

- 80. To nominate representatives on Association or institution having similar or allied objects on the committee of the Board or Committee of Governing Body or Board of Trustees of such other Association and / or institutions whenever interested in furthering the main objects of the company.
- 81. To enter into partnerships or any arrangement, whether in India or elsewhere, for union of interest, co-operation, reciprocal concession or otherwise with any person or Company carrying on or engaged in or about to carry on or engage in any activities or transaction which the Company is authorized to carry on or engage in or any activities or transaction capable of being conducted
- 82. To enter into any agreement with any Government or authorities (municipal, local or otherwise) or any corporations, companies, or persons, or any cooperative society or organisation or institutions in any part of the world which may seem conducive to the Company's objects or any of them and to obtain from any such Government authority, corporation, company or person any contracts, rights, moneys, privileges, licenses and concessions which may be thought by and/or on behalf of the Company desirable to obtain and to carry out, exercise and comply therewith.
- 83. To apply for secure, acquire by grant, legislative enactment, assignment, transfer purchase or otherwise and to exercise, carry out and enjoy and charter, license, power, authority, franchise, concession, right, or privilege, which any Government or authority, supreme, municipal, local or otherwise in any corporation or other public body may be empowered to grant, and to pay for, aid in and contribute towards carrying the same into effect, and to issue and / or appropriate any debentures or other securities and assets to defray the necessary costs, charges and expenses thereof.
- 84. To appeal, solicit, receive or accept grants from any government or nongovernmental institutions, agencies, authorities, public bodies, corporations, trusts, foundations, companies or person(s) and/or money, movable or immovable properties, donations, gifts, subscriptions, devices, bequests, and/or other assistance with a view to promoting the objects of the company and in receiving any gift of property to take the same either unconditionally or subject to any special conditions which may be prescribed by the donor in writing.
- 85. To open and maintain branches and to undertake such other activities for furtherance of all or any oneor more of the objects of the Company in accordance with the provisions made in the Rules and Regulations of the Company. To establish branches and offices in different parts of India and abroad
- 86. To establish and support or aid in the establishment and support of any charitable Association or Institution in all possible manner including giving donations in cash or kind for charitable purpose in any way connected with the purpose of the company or calculated to further its objects.
- 87. To take part information, management, subsiding supervision or control of the business or operations of any person(s), associations, company or undertaking and for that purpose to act as trustees, administrators, secretaries or in any other capacity or to appoint and administrators, managers or accounts or other experts or agent.
- 88. To improve, manage, work, develop, alter, exchange, lease, mortgage, charge, hypothecate, turn to account, abandon, dispose off or otherwise deal with all or any part of the property, rights, privileges and concessions of the Company, and to manufacture any articles or render any services with utilization of machineries, equipment and assets belonging to the Company.

- 89. To open and to operate current, savings and/or fixed deposit accounts with any bank or banks
 - 90. To make advances upon or for the purchase of land, buildings, houses, offices, flats, tenements, shops, other buildings and/or construction thereof; or for materials, goods, furniture, equipment, appliances and stores required for the Company's activities.
 - 91. To incur debts and obligations for the conduct of any business of the Company and to purchase or hiregoods, materials, equipment or machineries on credit or otherwise for and business or purpose of thisCompany.
 - 92. To borrow or raise money for the purpose of the company on such terms and on such security as the company may think fit
 - 93. To obtain any provisional rule, order stature or other legislative provision or enactment for enabling the Company to carry any of its objects into effect or for effecting any modification of the constitution of the Company or for any other purpose which may be expedient and to oppose any proceedings or applications which may seem calculated directly or indirectly to prejudice the Company's interests.
 - 94. To employ and engage skilled professionals, technical advisors, volunteers and interns in activities consistent with the main objects of the company or in the objects ancillary to the attainment of main objects of the company with or without remuneration, professional fees or honorarium.
 - 95. To appoint legal advisors and to appoint the banker or bankers for the company and to pay the necessary expenses for the same.
 - 96. To pay all costs, charges, expenses incurred in connection with incorporation of the Company including preliminary expenses of any kind and incidental to the formation of the Company, costs, charges and expenses of negotiating contracts and arrangements made prior to and in anticipation of the formationand incorporation of the Company.
- 97. To do all such other lawful things as considered necessary for the furtherance of the above objects.
 - 98. No objects of the Company will be carried out without obtaining prior approval from the concerned authorities.

- 4. The Objects of the Company shall extend to the whole of India.
 - 5. (i) The profits, if any, or any other income and property of the company, whatsoever derived shall be applied solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this Memorandum.
 - (ii) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to persons who, at any time are or have been members of the company or to anyone or more of them or to any person claiming throughanyone or more of them.
 - (iii) No remuneration other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the Company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the Company or not, except payments of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises letto the company.
 - (iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not beingmember), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.
 - (v) Nothing in clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company.
 - 6. No alteration shall be made to this Memorandum of Association or to the Articles of Association of the Company which are for the time being in force, unless the alteration has been previously submitted to and approved by the Registrar.
 - 7. The liability of the members is Limited by guarantee
 - 8. Each member, undertakes to contribute to the assets of the company in the event of its being wound up while he is a member or within one year afterwards, for payment of the debts or liabilities of the company contracted before he ceases to be a member and of the costs, charges and expenses of winding up, and for adjustment of the rights of the contributories among themselves such amount asmay be required not exceeding a sum of Rs. 100000.
 - 9. True accounts shall be kept of all sums of money received and expended by the Company and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure take place, and of the property, credits andliabilities of the Company, and subject to any reasonable restrictions as to the time and manner of inspecting the same that may be imposed in accordance with the regulation of the Company for the time being in force, the account shall be open to the inspection of the members. Once at least in everyyear, the accounts of the Company shall be examined and the correctness of the balance sheet and theincome and expenditure account ascertained by one or more properly qualified auditor or auditors.
 - 10.If upon winding up or dissolution of the Company, there remains, after the satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be distributed amongst the members of the Company but shall be given or transferred to such other company having objects similar to the objects of this Company, subject to such conditions as the tribunal may impose or may be sold and proceeds thereof credited to the Rehabilitation and Insolvency Fund formed under section 269 of the Act.
 - 11. The Company can be amalgamated only with another company registered under section 8 of the Actand having similar objects.
